AUCTIONEER'S NOTES

Well, the last auction proved to be roaring success and a big thank you to my clients across Canada and elsewhere. Spring is currently in the air here in Calgary between snow storms and the last couple of weeks has been a storm of paintings coming in. It was difficult choice for the front cover and what to use. The Maurice Cullen is a very fine example of the artist's work and has not been on the open market for several decades; the David Milne is another fine painting from later in his career. But obviously I selected the George Browne painting of 'The Bard' - why? It is a sensitive painting of not just any horse but 'The Bard' - a friend of the family [dare I say family member] done by a friend of the family. It was probably painted just west of Cochrane looking up the Bow Valley where the client lived. Now I should have remembered how many hands high the horse was and maybe I can find out that information before the auction but I felt it was in some ways this was a typical Southern Alberta painting and in some ways very rare. George Browne died at a young age of 40 and was obviously very talented. His paintings are quite rare; his hunting paintings are highly sought after and hopefully, we will discover, so are his equestrian paintings.

There are several other highlights I would like to point out. I seem to have accumulated a reasonable number of fine drawings by such artists as Stanley Cosgrove, E.J. Hughes, Kathleen Munn, Stanley Royle and Frederick Varley. Just because there is no colour, do not be afraid - these are fine examples of the artist's work and in many cases, more intimate and revealing. As well, a reasonable number of wildlife paintings have come in such as Don Li-Leger, Douglas Manning, Ron Parker and not to forget an original Robert Bateman landscape. I hope you enjoy the great diversity of the auction.

I would also like to add a correction to the The Buyer's Premium that takes effect immediately. The Buyer's Premium is 15% for sales up to and including \$50,000, 10% on amounts thereafter. There appears to a fair amount of activity on the horizon and the fall season could be a very busy one. If you are thinking of consigning, I would recommend doing it sooner rather than later. A sincere thank-you to our consignors and clientele across the continent. Have a great spring and I look forward to seeing or hearing from you at the auction.






